On your invoice from Christchurch City Council you will see a charge for Environment Canterbury's rates. These rates are collected for us by Christchurch City Council so you only have one bill to pay.

# Making sense of your invoice

### **Types of rates**

**General rates** — are charged based on the capital value and location of your property.

**Uniform Annual General Charge (UAGC)** — is a standard charge which is the same for all rateable units regardless of property value.

**Targeted rates or differentials (D)** — are charged where there is a specific benefit to the property owner. Rates can be targeted by service or geographical area.

#### What your rates pay for

- Air quality Air pollution reduction by carrying out activities in the Canterbury Air Regional Plan and assisting with getting new home heating technology into people's homes.
- Flood protection (D) and regional river works
   Reducing the impact of flooding by works
   and services on river control and flood protection.
   This work is charged both regionally and

- according to location and proximity to river. Coding for flood protection indicates which river catchment (eg WEC – Waimakariri-Eyre-Cust), and risk level (eg Class A – high risk).
- Civil Defence Emergency Management —
   Making sure we're prepared in the event of disaster.
- Healthier Homes Canterbury —
   Repayment of a loan for a Clean Heat
   appliance and/or insulation installation.
- Pest management Control of invasive and destructive animal and plant pests through inspection, advice, education, monitoring and investigation.
- Pest Free Banks Peninsula Activities supporting the Pest Free Banks Peninsula initiative.
- Biodiversity Works to support a flourishing environment, particularly native flora and fauna.
- Rabbit control (D)
- Public transport (D) Planning and delivering a sustainable public transport service.

- Greater Christchurch Transport and Urban Development — Working with other councils and agencies to plan for and support the needs of a growing region.
- Freshwater management A collaborative framework to help manage the region's freshwater resource.
